





PROJECT INFORMATION

The Erie Road Improvements project consists of the reconstruction of Erie Road, an east-west route through the community of Parrish. The east segment of this project will widen approximately one mile of Erie Road from Martha Road to US 301 from two lanes to four lanes (two in each direction) separated by a 22-foot-wide raised median and curb and gutter on both sides. A shared-use path will be constructed on the south side of Erie Road. A HAWK system, or high emphasis crosswalk signal, will also be constructed at Martha Road. Additional enhancements include median lighting and construction of a fully closed drainage system with stormwater ponds.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS AND BENEFITS




-  Improves safety for all roadway users along Erie Road by providing additional road capacity, a shared-use path, and street lighting
-  Provides additional roadway capacity to support anticipated increase in traffic volume from Parrish Community High School
-  Improves stormwater management and drainage infrastructure along the Erie Road corridor
-  Reduces traffic congestion, enhancing vehicular traffic operations and function of the corridor
